

Uniform Guidelines – Years 7 to 11

Appearance - Colfe's requires all pupils to dress smartly in order to reflect the identity of the school. Pupils must conform to the dress and appearance regulations at all times of the day when travelling to and from school, and on all school occasions, unless alternative instructions are given by a member of staff. Pupils must be neat and tidy at all times.

Uniform list - Skirts, trousers, shirts, blouses and jumpers must be those on the following uniform lists. Jumpers should bear the school logo.

Shirts/blouses - Shirts and blouses should be tucked in. Coloured garments should not be visible under school shirts.

Shoes - Shoes should be black and polishable, have low heels and no logos. Trainers, boots and ankle boots are not permitted.

Hair - Hairstyles should be of conventional appearance. Hair must be tied back for practical lessons. Only natural colour dyes are permitted.

Hair accessories - Navy, brown, black and plain gold/silver permitted. They should be functional rather than decorative.

Jewellery - A pair of plain studs may be worn in the earlobe. No other jewellery is permitted, unless for religious reasons, in which case parental consent must be given.

Coats - Coats should be navy, black or grey without logos.

Scarves - Navy, black or grey.

Make up - Discreet makeup is permitted for girls in Y9 and above.

Skirt length - Just above the knee or longer.

Ties - Ties should cover the top button of the shirt which should be done up. There should be at least 5 roebucks in a vertical line under the knot.

Tights/socks - Plain navy or black tights. White, blue or black short or knee length socks for girls. No trainer socks with school shoes. Black or grey socks for boys.

Blazers - Blazers should be worn at all times whilst in school and on the journey to and from school. Pupils are permitted to remove their blazers during break and lunchtime when playing outside.

Nails - Clear nail varnish only. No extensions.

All clothing and property should be clearly marked with your child's name

Business/City Dress

- A smart business suit in Dark Colours – navy, black or charcoal grey
- A smart business shirt/blouse – pink, blue or white or combinations
- Black shoes

GIRLS:

- Skirt Length – just above the knees to mid-calf
- City shorts/three-quarter length trousers are not acceptable
- Fine or opaque (navy/black/flesh coloured) tights may be worn
- Black/navy/charcoal grey woollen v-neck jumpers may be worn under the suit jacket in the winter
- Top coats for winter wear should be plain black, grey or navy and of formal business style

BOYS:

- Black/navy/charcoal v-neck jumpers may be worn under the suit jacket in winter
- Sixth Form or Prefect's tie, as appropriate
- Boys should be clean-shaven at all times and are not permitted to wear jewellery
- Top coats for winter wear should be plain black, grey or navy and of a formal business style

PIERCINGS & MAKE-UP:

- Jewellery and make up should be minimal and discreet (e.g. single, fine chains are permitted as are ear studs/sleepers but no other facial or tongue piercings are permitted)

The above list is not meant to be exhaustive but instead represents a guideline on the meaning of City/Business dress. An email will be sent home for a second repeated offence after which the student may be sent home.
