Uniform Guidelines

Appearance – Colfe's requires all pupils to dress smartly in order to reflect the identity of the school.

Hair – Hair styles should not draw attention to the child. We do not allow colouring, designs and shapes and/or obvious use of gel or wax. We expect girls' hair to be tied back neatly away from their faces with a plain blue or black band, clip or discreet scrunchy / ribbon.

Jewellery – No jewellery is allowed, the only exception being discreet ear studs, as flat to the ear as possible. A discreet analogue or digital watch may be worn. All earrings and watches must be removed before sports, PE and swimming lessons. Nail varnish or other make-up is not permitted.
